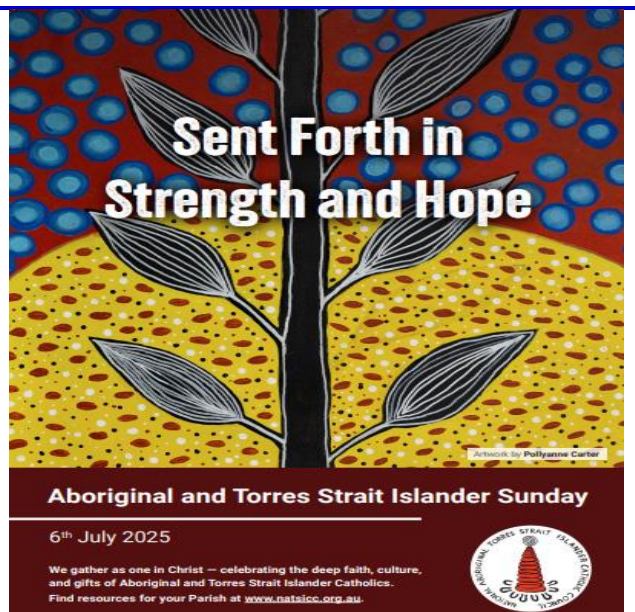

Carlo Acutis to be canonized

Pope Leo XIV held the first Ordinary Public Consistory of his pontificate on Friday morning, with Cardinals giving their formal approval for the canonizations of eight Blesseds. During the ceremony, the Holy Father announced that Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized on Sunday, **7 September in Rome**. The canonization of this young saint, the first millennial saint, has been greatly anticipated due to the great devotion to the Eucharist. He is also the model of inspiration to our Young People in this modern world. Let us pray for our school children and all our children through the intercession of St. Carlo Acutis.
