Important Notice - WWCC and Code of Conduct

To all our wonderful volunteers, Thank you for your commitment to ministry in our parish. We would be unable to continue to provide pastoral and administrative support to our parishioners and community members without your dedication and support.

It is a requirement in NSW the requirement is for anyone over 18 years of age involved in activities with children or the elderly to hold a current Working With Children Check (WWCC). At a parish level, this applies to parish priests/staff/volunteers active in particular ministries. Twice a year, we are required to send a report of all active WWCC holders to the Institute for Professional Standards and Safeguarding office (IPSS) in the Archdiocesan Chancery. Our parish is committed to the safeguarding of children and vulnerable persons and complying with Archdiocesan and Government requirements for WWC. Please help us to maintain accurate records for the audits by ensuring your WWC is current. We are also updating our Code of Conduct forms. If you are involved in any activities in our Church, you need to read and sign a Code of Conduct form and send it to the office for recording. There are blank forms at the back of the Church. Thank you to those who have already completed their Code of Conduct and up-dated their WWCC.
