With 19 years in the role of Commissioner, Dr Watchirs has national and international expertise in health and human rights and has built a formidable career in fostering the rights of all. Among many prestigious awards, she has received an OAM for human rights in 2010 and was ACT Senior Woman of the Year in 2020.

Triumph Lenten Program 2023



Where the Church is

There are 168 hours in a week. Many people attend church for an hour on Sunday.
