Prayer for the Parish Mission

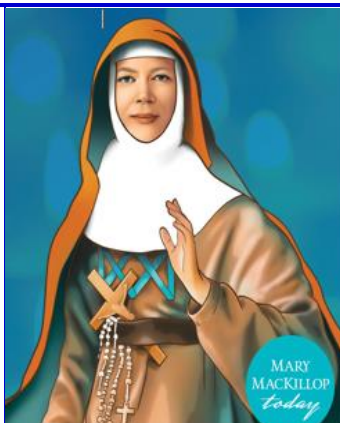
O Most Holy Virgin, immaculate in body and spirit look kindly on us as we implore your powerful intercession.
