JULY - MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD


The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

COVID RESTRICTIONS

Once again, we are to observe the following restrictions and protocols:

- 1. Masks indoors are mandatory for those 12 years +
- 2. Priest (when celebrating Liturgy) and Lectors (when proclaiming the Word) can dispense with the mask
- Priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must wear 3. masks when distributing the Sacred Host
- 4. No congregational singing, but a cantor (x4) can sing if 4m² from congregation
- 5. Holy Communion only under the species of bread
- 6. Holy Communion to be received only in the hand
- 7. No touching at the sign of peace
- 8. Collection bags not to be passed around, but can be placed on an extended stick to allow collection of cash by a few parishioners
- Apply the 4m² rule to all liturgies and gatherings (except funerals). 9. 60 people max at Immaculate Conception.



Funerals

10. Restricted to 100 persons.

Other Matters

- 11. Service NSW App is mandatory, please sign in using the QR Code at entrance or on bulletin
- 12. Physical roster is reasonable for those who are unable to use the App (keep for 30 days)
- 13. Availability of hand sanitiser is essential
- 14. Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 4m² rule.
