#### MARCH DEVOTION - ST JOSEPH

The Bible pays Joseph the highest compliment: he was a "just" man. When the Bible speaks of God "justifying" someone, it means that God, the all-holy or "righteous" one, so transforms a person that the individual shares somehow in God's own holiness, and hence it is really "right" for God to love him or her.

By saying Joseph was "just," the Bible means that he was one who was completely open to all that God wanted to do for him. He became holy by opening himself totally to God.

# FEAST OF ST JOSEPH



19 March is the Feast of St Joseph, Foster-father of Jesus, the most chaste spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Head of the Holy Family.

# FEAST OF THE ANNUNICATION

Friday 25th March is the Feast of the Annunciation. First, it celebrates the actual Incarnation of Our Savior -- the Word made flesh in the womb of His mother, Mary. Second, it is a principal Marian feast. Some other lessons that can be drawn from this extremely important feast are: Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Angels as God's messengers. The importance of humility, submission and obedience to God's will, and the value of hiddenness, silence, quiet (baby in womb, Mary at home etc).

#### LENTEN REFLECTION

Throughout his journey to Jerusalem, Jesus has been teaching about the Kingdom of God. In this parable, we find an image of God's patience and hopefulness as he prepares his Kingdom. God calls us to repent, and it is within his power to punish us for our failure to turn from our sinfulness. And yet God is merciful. He delays punishment and tends to us so that we may yet bear the fruit he desires from us.

### POPE TO CONSECRATE RUSSIA TO IMMACULATE HEART

Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Friday, 25 March, during the Celebration of Penance that he will preside over at 5pm in St Peter's Basilica.

The day of the Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord was chosen for the consecration.

In the apparition of 13 July 1917, in Fatima, Our Lady had asked for the consecration of Russia to Her Immaculate Heart, stating that if this request were not granted, Russia would spread "its errors throughout the world, promoting wars and persecution of the Church."

Please pray for the conversion of Russia, the end of war, and for the time of peace promised by Our Lady.
