The NSW government has announced the staged lifting of restrictions.

From Friday 18th Feb – QR check-in only required for nightclubs, and music festivals with more than 1000 people, singing and dancing permitted

From Friday 25th February - mask mandated only for public transport, planes, airports, hospitals and aged care facilities, correctional facilities & indoor music festivals with more than 1000 people.


## FEBRUARY DEVOTION - THE HOLY FAMILY
