Eileen O'Connor, the cause for her canonisation opened in 2018 by the Vatican's Congregation for the Causes of Saints. Australia may soon have its second saint!

Eileen's legacy – the mission of 'Our Lady's Nurses for the Poor' affectionately known as the 'Brown Nurses' – ranks among the great and enduring social works of Caroline Chisholm and Saint Mary MacKillop. At a time when no publicly funded healthcare was available, the order was dedicated to caring for the sick and dying poor in their homes.
