Dear parishioners,

It's been five weeks since the doors of the churches were closed for public worship. I hear lots of positive stories about where many feel the importance of Eucharist and sacraments in their life and participating liturgies online. This time of trial proved to be a moment of grace as well.

I am truly humbled by the responses and support I receive during this COVID 19 lockdown. Some of you asked me how I am surviving financially since there are no collections in our churches for the foreseeable future. The reality is that all our first collection is given to the diocesan central presbytery account and the diocese pays priests the monthly stipend (though I may have to sacrifice my salary for the next few months along with other priests in the diocese). As you would know most of those first collection comes in the form of cash and very few through electronic transfer. So that money is considerably reduced in the diocesan central presbytery account. If you can afford, I emphasis, only if you can afford, please do take up electronic payment for both collections. On the contrary, if any of you are struggling and still continues to pay because of obligation or any other feelings, and you are embarrassed to talk about it, please send me a mail joshy.kurien@cg.org.au and we will talk about it and help you to endure this difficult time.

Irrespective of my salary cut I have decided to remain on Planned Giving to Goulburn, Crookwell and Taralga parishes in the Goulburn Mission and that's my sense of belongingness and shared ownership.

Many thanks to people who have increased their giving and people who have embraced the electronic transfer. Thank you for your thoughtfulness and support. May the Lord reward your generosity.
