### **Twenty Five Years Young**

As Tuesday, the Feast of the Transfiguration is the 25th anniversary of the parish it is opportune to recall matters past. Outside the Holy Trinity Church is a bell tower. The bell was cast from two bells. The older of the bells was cast in Dublin in 1853. It was intended for St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney but on arrival was found to be cracked and never used. It ended up in Canberra through Archbishop O'Brien who came from Sydney. Foundation Parish Priest Fr Barney Lynch, himself from Ireland, arranged for the bell to be melted down at the Navy's Garden Island dockyard along with an early twentieth century bell cast in Sydney. According to the 'The Australian Women's Weekly' of 20 June, 1973 "the marriage between the Irish immigrant and the Australian bell went off perfectly" (p.4).

Before returning to Canberra Fr Lynch's bell "tolled 19 times in memory of the 19 men killed on HMAS

Kuttabul, sunk at Garden Island in 1942 by a Japanese midget submarine." Parishioners can fondly recall the privilege as children of being allowed to toll the bell on Sunday. The bell is now rung electronically; at least it will be when some gremlins in the system are fixed. Another twist to this story is that one of the foremen on the job at Garden Island was a relative of Fr Lynch's. Long may we celebrate our past as we move forward with founded confidence in God's abiding presence. With this awareness, we will gather on Tuesday for the usual 9.30am Mass followed at 12 noon by a Mass which will see both of our parish school communities gather. Fr John
