BEING A DISCIPLE

What's this in today's Gospel about 'hating' your father and mother? Surely not. Only last Sunday we honoured and praised dads. Scripture scholar Brendan Byrne SJ points out that most Semitic languages lack an equivalent for our English word 'prefer'. The default position is that you then either 'love' or 'hate'. The point is that a disciple is called to give priority to throwing their lot in with Jesus. This might cause tension with loved ones and friends, to say nothing of cultural norms. Therefore, as Jesus points out in today's Gospel, consider carefully before becoming a disciple. And yet whatever the cost, even death, nothing compares to the supreme blessing of following Jesus. St Francis of Assisi and St Teresa of Calcutta reminded us of this truth: It is in giving that we receive. Further, being a disciple is not just a one-off decision. The commitment needs ongoing nurture. Pope Francis has said, "Because faith, which is always God's gift and always to be asked for, must be nutured by us. It is no magic power which comes down from heaven, it is not a 'talent' which is given once and for all, not a special force for solving life's problems."

How will I nurture my faith, my relationship with the Lord this week?
