## SPRING AND NEW LIFE

This weekend marks the end of the football season. Hopefully, the Raiders can realise the goal that evaded the GWS. Spring and warmer weather finds resonance in the call of Pope Francis for October to be an 'Extraordinary Missionary Month' (see comment of Archbishop Christopher in the latest Catholic Voice, p 2 available in the foyer). If ever there was a man with a mission it was St Francis of Assisi. We celebrated his feast on Friday (4 Oct). Wed to 'lady poverty' in his unqualified commitment to Christ, the life of Francis reflected the comment attributed to him, "Preach always and if needs be on occasion use words". Francis was imbued with a deep sense of the joy arising from what we call the 'Incarnation' (from the Latin 'in carnus' meaning 'in- the-flesh'). God is with us! The awareness of that truth saw him popularise the nativity scene with live animals. The openness in Jesus to the Father's will saw him teach, heal and forgive but the religious and political authorities were not open to the transformation he lived. They crucified him. Francis, this lover of nature and teacher was graced to share with joy in the cross of Christ by bearing the stigmata or five wounds of the crucified Jesus. Faith sustained Francis in all things. True faith is manifest in mission. In other words, what we believe is reflected in what we do. It has been said that the Church has a mission. But if God has become one with us in all things - and I mean all things - then we might more truly say that 'the mission has a Church'. While the Church is a sign and instrument of communion with God, the mission is bigger than the Church as a community. Indeed, whenever I respond to the movement of the Holy Spirit in whatever my circumstances then I am furthering the mission of the Church and the mission of God who seeks to become one with us. Where is the Spirit calling me to further the mission this month? Personal prayer and reflection on the lives of the saints (how about your Confirmation saint?) would be good places to discern a response. Fr John
