ABIDING PRESENCE!

Merry Christmas and peace to all! The cause of our celebration is that 'God is with us', all of us and for all time. The angel proclaims "Listen, I bring you news of great joy, a joy to be shared by the whole people." Today we should celebrate and rejoice. The Church speaks of the Christmas Season or 'Octave of Christmas' so that the awesome truth of God's abiding presence might sink in. Christmas is not just a day, it is an awareness, an attitude. Christmas is to be shared. I recall an episode of 'Call the Midwife' in which it was stated that the hand of God is sometimes at the end of your arm. The handshakes and hugs of this day symbolise our being connected and that God is with all of us. Beyond

passing sentiment, will the outstretched arms of the infant in the crib find ongoing engagement with you? The infant speaks to our thirst for communion, for completion, whatever our age or circumstance. And sometimes we need to be that vulnerable infant in reaching out to another in their need. Christmas is not just a day, it is an awareness, an attitude. Christmas is to be shared.

Last year I left out copies of a Christmas reflection by Fr Peter Day, a priest of our archdiocese. I have done so again this year. Peter is perhaps best known for his work in establishing 'HOME' in Queanbeyan for those living on the margins. As I said last year, while I would want to discuss some points that Peter makes, it is a very engaging read. Copies of the reflection are available in the foyer.
