IN SOLIDARITY

Today's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of the Christmas Season. On Christmas Day we celebrated God being one with us. Last Sunday's celebration of the Epiphany saw us identify with the Magi who deferred to Jesus, the source of all wisdom. Today's gospel sees John the Baptist defer to Jesus who identifies with all in their need. The voice of the Father vindicates the status of Jesus as beloved son. It is in our need that God's Spirit seeks to identify with each and all of us as beloved sons or daughters. However the self-righteous have no need of John's baptism nor Jesus's ministry of healing and forgiveness. And so from the moment of Jesus's baptism a pattern is established: some acknowledge their need while others presume to deny it. Yet while the self-righteous baulk at putting their trust in the Lord, no one appears to be indifferent to the impact of the bushfires and the prolonged drought. We are all in need, we are all humbled in our solidarity. Perhaps we might therein be open to the One who calls all? Meanwhile, in response to our shared need, our Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Finance Council have decided to donate \$5000 to the Archdiocesan fund to support parishes impacted by the bushfires. The

Australian Catholic Bishops Conference have also called for parishes to support the **Vinnies Bushfires Appeal by a 'retiring collection' over the Australia Day weekend.** Finally, those who wish to volunteer can contact **emergencyvolunteering.com.au.** These initiatives bespeak our solidarity in time of need, especially when we gather for the Sunday Eucharist, 'the source and summit' of our life in Christ.
