#### A NEW PERSPECTIVE

Following recent protests around the country, comedian Sammy J has produced a timely skit on 'male toxicity'. It has drawn mixed reactions. I think it makes a telling point. Others disagree. Why not check it out at https://youtu.be/IJGpt73omWc. Sometimes to truly see we need a new perspective. As we celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Lent, we are being called to a new perspective. In our First Reading the prophet Jeremiah calls us to a new covenant written not on tablets of stone but on our hearts. His audience understood the heart as the life-principle, the core of one's being, not just a symbol for romantic love. This call is personal. The new covenant was realised in Jesus. He lived out of a deep personal awareness of his Father's call. In the very core of his being he had doubts about his capacity to see it through (cf. the agony in the garden). Yet, as our Second Reading notes, "Although he was Son, he learnt to obey through suffering [and] became for all who obey him the source of eternal salvation" (Heb 5:9). The Gospel takes up the same point in speaking of a grain of wheat dying and producing a rich harvest. The Gospel also reflects the experience of the early Church in referencing "some Greeks" who would "like to see Jesus" (John 12:21). To 'see' Jesus is to see him fully revealed on the cross in openness to the Father's will. If we are to truly see Jesus, we must be willing to look upon the cross not as a mere article of devotion but as a call 'to let go and let God'

in order to produce a "rich harvest". To see Jesus truly is to trust and to follow him. Like Sammy J's skit, Lent calls us to a new perspective. We are being called to a new perspective as both citizens and as disciples. Fr John
