### **FAITH IN ACTION**

If faith is mediated through culture, as was noted in last week's bulletin, then the faith of some is sorely tested at present. Take Myanmar (formerly Burma). Air strikes, ground assault and massacre of 2,300 civilians following a military coup in February 2021. The sentencing of Australian Professor Sean Turrell, economic adviser to Aung San Suu Kyi, might motivate a more direct Australian response to a country in our region. As an aside, I note that seminarians from Myanmar have studied at Good Shepherd Seminary, Sydney. Take Hong Kong. Cardinal Joseph Zen, 90, former bishop of Hong Kong and critic of the Chinese Communist Party, went on trial recently for his role in a relief fund supporting pro-democracy protests in 2019. Zen has strongly criticised the Vatican's deal with Beijing over the appointment of clergy. Take the fastest growing group of homeless people in Australia, women over 50. The soon to be released documentary 'Under Cover' looks at the experiences of 10 homeless women from various backgrounds (Palace Electric from 6 October). Too political? Well, it was the threat of the Babylonians that saw the prophet Habakkuk in our First Reading cry out "How long, O Lord? I cry for help but you do not listen!" The prophet reassures the people that God will not disappoint them. St Paul's sense of faith is "enduring trust in God's faithfulness, despite

appearances to the contrary" (Brendan Byrne). The Gospel makes clear that people of persevering faith manifest God's power in the world. But here's the rub: perseverance in faith arises from an awareness of and abiding gratitude for all God has already done for us. Faith is a response to God's goodness. It gives rise to praise, gratitude and action. In other words, faith is expressed in communal and personal prayer and doing justice for the sake of the reign of God. The Church - all of us - must foster dialogue and engagement in sharing the generosity of God. Lord, teach me to be generous; teach me to serve you as you deserve, to give without counting the cost, to fight and not to heed the wounds, to toil and not to seek for rest, to labour and not to ask for reward, except to know that I am doing your will. Amen ('The Prayer of Generosity' – Attributed to St Ignatius of Loyola).
