ONE GRAIN - ONE OCEAN

Australians pride themselves on being 'doers'. Get on with it! John the Baptist was a doer. He called folk to renewal as he baptised them in the Jordan. He was a 'straight shooter'. In today's Gospel John tells different groups what to do if they were fair dinkum about renewal. He called them to 'walk the talk'. But why? Because the self-sufficient will not be open to the imminent coming of the Messiah. The religious authorities dismissed John and the political authorities did away with him. In time, the same groups conspired to do away with Jesus. The self-absorbed continue to undermine human flourishing. Others speak and act for it. On Thursday I attended a talk by former ABC and now Nine political commentator Chris Uhlmann, "Australia's Identity Crisis", part of the ACU's 'Ethos' initiative addressing public ethics. Uhlmann drew on his professional, personal and seminary experience to affirm the Judeo-Christian basis of our liberal democracy and cautioned about increasing threats to it. He acknowledged the failures of the Church and of our political system to live up to ideals founded in religious aspiration. Nonetheless, he argued cogently for a resolute defence of that which ensures our common good in a robust yet respectful diversity. In a consistent vein, Fr Peter Day on Tuesday night in our Parish Centre called us to share the loving gaze of Jesus. He spoke of how we have

outsourced so much of what is foundational to the Gospel, thereby removing the interpersonal engagement. Peter lives in the 'HOME' in Queanbeyan with marginalized folk who, like all of us, seek a place to lay their head with dignity and respect. Mutual respect founded in our being created in the image of the divine is foundational to our personal and communal well-being. The alternative is a bleak march to nothingness. We cannot change the world but we can impact our part of it. On Monday, Fr Peter's article, 'Simplicity, Contemplation, Service' was published in the online Catholic news service, "La Croix International". Copies are available in the foyer. In part Peter said, "In the pondering the life of that "holy fool astride the donkey", I continue to be intrigued by his itinerant nature, by the fact that he spent the vast bulk of his time in small, unassuming locales amongst 'small', unassuming peoples. To walk in emptiness with blind trust is the way of contemplation, the Way of Christ. But do I have the faith and the courage to be "unseen" . . . to dissolve into the Divine marinade as if a tiny grain of sand . . .? This being "unseen", . . . should not be mistaken for timid diffidence, or a sweet humility. After all, while each grain of sand is seemingly insignificant and dispensable, it is – in communion with all the other grains of sand – also the beach; also the ocean floor!"
