#### **BEING PRESENT IN ABSENCE**

**Prayer has been spoken of raising one's heart and mind to God. We are encouraged to pray as we can, not as we think we must. Whatever our style of prayer, today's readings speak of the need for persistence.** *"Faith in God, displayed in prayer that is both trusting and calm as well as constant and persistent, is the right attitude for the present time – at a time of waiting and hope, rather than possession of the Kingdom" (Brendan Byrne).* Karl Rahner, arguably the greatest theologian of the twentieth century, said *"In the days ahead, you will either be a mystic (one who has experienced God for real) or nothing at all".* He also said, *"When a man or woman is with God in awe and love, then they are praying".* St Teresa of Avila (1515 – 1582) lived during the flowering of the Protestant Reformation. She brought life to Christianity not through argument and debate, but rather emphasises on *"quiet, contemplation and teaching based on a personal relationship with the God: 'I shall speak of nothing of which I have no experience ... or which the Lord has not taught me in prayer.' Teresa had a homely sense of humour: she wrote the 'Way of Perfection' knowing that none of us is perfect. We can only be the best friends of God we can" (Michael McGirr). Teresa's close friend St John of the Cross (1542 – 1591) experienced 'a* 

dark night of the soul'. He claimed that we experience God in nothingness. *"It was a bleak experience of the absence of God in which God is somehow painfully present" (McGirr).* Perhaps a certain absence of God both within ourselves and our community is bespeaking the presence of God in ways that we are yet to articulate and to embody? Perhaps the Spirit is calling us to reorientate in our deserts? A dark night will always reveal a new day. *O Christ, our Morning Star, Splendour of Light Eternal, shining with the glory of the rainbow, come and waken us from the greyness of our apathy, and renew in us the gift of hope. Amen (St Bede the Venerable).*
