BELOVED AND CALLED TO FOLLOW

The Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan ushers in his public ministry. John the Baptist explains that his baptism with water is in preparation for the coming of the promised Messiah, in contrast to that of the *"stronger one"* who will baptise *"with the Holy Spirit and fire"*. The latter anticipates Pentecost. *"Essentially, then, the role of the Stronger One (Jesus) will be to cleanse and empower people with the gift of the Spirit, the force of the messianic era that is now at hand"* (Brendan Byrne). **The descent of the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove is an anointing of Jesus to rebuild the People of God in the love of the Father that has been poured out on him.** At the Jordan there is a trinitarian understanding of God if not the fulness of the later doctrine of the Trinity: the mission of the Son is to draw humanity back into communion with the Father, into the "fire" of the divine communion of love which

is the life of the Spirit. As with Jesus, so we are to each hear the Father's voice from heaven: "You are my beloved son; you are my beloved daughter; in you I am well pleased". Fr Timothy Radcliffe, the former Master of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), in a homily the week before Christmas spoke of a pervasive lack of hope and confidence. "It's not just Omicron, but a sense that history is not going anywhere. There's a rise of violence, threats of war, the ecological catastrophe... Many young people say they don't want to have children because they don't want to bring them into a world that has no future. But we believe in God's future. . . . I love the word "confidence" — from the Latin con fidens, "believing together". We must share our hope. Hope and despair are contagious. And every one of us makes a choice of whether we are going to be a source of hope or a source of despair." Commenting on the way of prudence founded in the gift of Wisdom, Radcliffe noted that "Prudence is living in the real world. And the real world is God's world. And in that world we are travelling to fulfillment. . . So let's not procrastinate. Let's act today. Who are the people from whom we must ask forgiveness? Today. Who are the people that must I reach out to in kindness? There's no time to waste. (Reported by Robert Mickens in La Croix International, 6 Jan 2022).
