CANBERRA INNER NORTH CATHOLIC COMMUNITY





Throughout 2023 a series of meetings, consultations and discussions in each of the parishes of the inner north namely: St. Joseph's (O'Connor), St. Brigid's (Dickson), Holy Rosary (Watson) and St. Thomas More (Campbell) together with St. Patrick's Church (Braddon) have considered various ways of increasing collaboration and sharing of ministries, personnel and resources. These consultation s have brought about a tangible outcome in the form of a reconfiguration. Starting on the 3rd of December, 2023 (1st Week of Advent), these Canberra Inner North Parishes will be administered by the Blessed Sacrament Fathers (Philippine Province).

While each parish will maintain its parochial identity, Frs. Sebastian Luistro, SSS, Renoir Oliver, Jr., SSS and Anthony (Thonn) Riosa, SSS will be working together in their sacramental and administrative role attending to the needs of the faithful of each parishes. For practical reasons a number of

aspects of administration, such as a common bulletin, will evolve over coming months. I will share more information about what will change and what will stay the same in future bulletins.

What is the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament and who is their Founder?

The Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament is a religious congregation within the Roman Catholic Church, founded in 1856 in Paris, France by St. Peter Julian Eymard. It is a clerical religious Institute of pontifical right, composed of priests, deacons and brothers with members in 29 countries on 5 continents. The abbreviation SSS attached to the individual religious name stands for Latin words Societas Sanctissimi Sacramenti, which means Society of the Blessed Sacrament or Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament. Its central government, the General Council is based in Rome, Italy. Its charism is the Eucharist having the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament as the extension of the Eucharistic celebration. In Australia, two communities are present in Sydney (St. Peter Julian Catholic Church, George St., Haymarket) and in Melbourne (St. Francis Church, Lonsdale Street).

St. Peter Julian Eymard, whose feast is celebrated in the liturgical calendar of the Catholic Church every 2nd of August, was born in La Mure, France on 4 February, 1811. His great passion and zeal for Jesus in the Eucharist led him in the foundation of the Congregation for men and likewise the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament for women, promoting the devotion and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. He says: "Jesus is there in the Blessed Sacrament (Eucharist), everybody to Him!" He was canonized by St. John XXIII on 9 December, 1962 at the beginning of the Second Vatican Council and called the "Apostle of the Eucharist."

May this reconfiguration of the Canberra Inner North Parishes lead the faithful towards spiritual maturity, communion and friendship with the Eucharistic Lord Jesus.
