REFLECTION: God chooses human beings to communicate the divine message and we can sometimes be amazed at the people God chooses. Amos, the shepherd, had no auglifications to speak in God's name yet he was the one God chose. The Twelve sent out by Jesus were similarly unremarkable. Most amazingly perhaps, God has chosen us also, chosen us in Christ, to be spiritually blessed and to praise the glory of his grace. Of course, not everyone will accept the wonderful message we bring. Indeed some will react negatively to both the message and the messenger. This was the experience of Amos and the Twelve. Jesus urges us not to dwell on such rejections, We should let them go - shake the dust from our feet—and continue to be a (From Gods Word, Daily Reflections 2024) voice that speaks of peace.
