



## Season of Creation – Integral Ecology Pilgrimage

We will be soon entering the Season of Creation, the annual Christian celebration when we pray and respond to the cry of creation. During the season, which runs from the World Day of Prayer for Creation (1 September) to the Feast of St Francis of Assisi (4 October), the global ecumenical family comes together to listen and care for our common home. We unite this year around the theme Let Justice and Peace Flow.

As part of the celebration, the Archdiocese of Canberra-Goulburn, in collaboration with the Australian Catholic University, is offering a series of six online dialogue sessions, Integral ecology pilgrimage - Let Justice and Peace Flow, starting on 31 August. Sessions will cover: cry of the earth, cry of the poor; ecological spirituality; ecological economics; ecological education; adoption of simple lifestyles; and community resilience and empowerment. 'This dynamic, interactive and deep learning experience will give life to the global Laudato Si' goals - grounded on country, in eco-theology, and in Sacred Scripture.' #### Gospel Matthew 16:21-27

Jesus began to make it clear to his disciples that he was destined to go to Jerusalem and suffer grievously at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, to be put to death and to be raised up on the third day. Then, taking him aside, Peter started to remonstrate with him. 'Heaven preserve you, Lord,' he said. 'This must not happen to you.' But he turned and said to Peter, 'Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle in my path, because the way you think is not God's way but man's.'

Then Jesus said to his disciples, 'If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me.
