Parish Pastoral Council Report

So far this year we have been working on:

- 1) keeping abreast of the developments associated with the Affordable Rental Housing PROJECT and the potential provision of alternative parish office and priest's office.
 - (i) There have been acknowledged shortcomings in the consultation process which have been expressed by the school community. This has led to the extension of the time period for feedback.
 - (ii) Plans for the relocation of the parish and priest's office to the meeting room of the Church and sacristy storeroom respectively have been developed.
- 2) Responding to requests for the promotion of outreach activities, for example Refugee Action campaign
- 3) Exploring combined Schools/Parish Masses in connection with Easter and early Christmas
- 4) Revisiting the Renewal Goals in a critically reflective process
- 5) Examining opportunities for ministry acknowledgement and encouragement for a broader commitment
- 6) Reinforcing ways in which we can 'know parishioners by name' and share ways in which parishioners can deepen their faith commitment.
- 7) Welcoming and preparing Bridget Pigram to the PPC.
